



Requirements and conditions to participate at the European Summer School Berlin 2017

1. Social work student

You can participate in the Summer School if you are a student between 2nd & 4th year of a bachelor or a master program in social work.

2. Topic of the Summer School 2017

This year we'll focus on the topic „Social Sustainability“.

3. Application

For application you need a motivation letter (one page) and a letter of recommendation by a professor or tutor. Furthermore please fill in the Application form, which can be downloaded on our website. **The filing deadline is 6th of June 2017.**

4. Your contribution

As seen at the preliminary program is in process. We'll organize workshops where you have the chance and the duty to present a paper which will be a contribution from your country and your point of view to the topic of the Summer School.

5. European Credits Transfer System

If you participate in the Summer School which is a recognized module in our study program of social work you will get 3 ECTS. If you hand in a research paper to one of the subitems until **15th July 2017** you will receive 5 ECTS.

6. Certificate of Attendance

The requirements to receive the Certificate of Attendance will be to participate at the Summer School 2016 consistently (you'll get 3 ECTS) and write a controversy paper (1500 to 2000 words) concerning the main headline and at least one of the workshop topics. The paper shall be submitted by **July 15, 2017** and meet the academic standards. (you'll get 5 ECTS)

7. Course fees

Course Fees are 300€ (200 Euros for students from partner universities)

including:

- accommodation
- free coffee, tea and table water during the workshops
- sight seeing
- welcome and farewell party
- field trips
- as well as highly professional workshop-leaders
